Footnotes

DIRECT ORDER stalked the pace while never far back behind the dueling leaders, was angled out and rallied into the stretch, drew clear under heavy pressure. MY ASCENDANCY was in a good stalking position, was angled out and rallied on the far turn, drew off in upper stretch, faltered in the drive and began to fade. SWAINS ROYALTY was unhurried early, had a steady advance towards the front, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. CRAFTY GIGI was well placed in mid pack, rallied on the far turn and loomed a threat, hung in the stretch and began to fade. CHANTILLY SLEW was unhurried early, improved position but was no threat. SUCHA FANCY CAT dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, weakened and dropped back. JILL LYNN JONES was void of early speed, improved position but was no factor. SPRING IS SPRUNG passed tiring rivals. MONDAY MORNING set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. MELT DOWN showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. PEG'S MOST WANTED flashed brief speed before stopping.
