LIGHTNING ROAD was unhurried early while saving ground, rallied on the far turn, drew off through the stretch under firm handling. TAX MAN SAM stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch, was no match for the winner but was second best. TURNPIKE MIKE dueled for the lead and set the pace, drew clear on the backstretch and drew off on the far turn, weakened and began to fade. RIDE IN THE PARK was unhurried early, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. FINGER TAPPING dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. EOLOS failed to menace. TONE IT DOWN was no factor. JAYBIRD'S MIRACLE was no threat.
