WEDONIT raced just off the early pace, came through inside of SCIOTO BOOTSKI to challenge leaving the half mile marker, inched clear approaching the stretch, bore out under urging through the final furlong while remaining clear and prevailed. SCIOTO BOOTSKI set the pace from the two path on the backstretch, chased the winner around the turn, continued willingly through the drive and held second. GENERAL JOSH chased the pace racing three wide to the stretch, finished willingly and just missed second. WIREBENDER raced close up while four wide to the stretch before tiring.
