CHARLES ANTHONY was void of early speed while five wide, rallied into the stretch and circled the field, began to draw clear late under constant handling. HARRY CANARY dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, weakened in the stretch and was outfinished. J. Z. RIB was unhurried early while four wide, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. DOC MILL stalked the pace from the outside with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. PRINCE DEVILLIER dueled for the lead early, faltered and faded. TRI DELTA TRUE showed good early speed while four wide, had no rally. SOME PERFECT LEGEND failed to menace.
