WORTHY OF WINGS was unhurried early while five wide, was forced eight wide into the stretch, was all out to prevail in a long drive. SHEZA RUNAWAY STAR stalked the pace while never far back, rallied on the turn, was forced seven wide on the turn, was outfinished to the wire. T. T.'S SURPRISE was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch while saving ground, flattened out and ran evenly late. COCO'S MOUNTAIN set the pace with good early speed, bore out entering the stretch and forced foes out, faltered and faded. JEANNE'S HERO flashed brief speed on the inside, gave way and dropped back. PYRITE ALRIGHT showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. IMISSWHAT'SISNAME failed to menace. MARKET GENIUS flashed brief speed before stopping.
