MAGIC ROCK raced inside past the quarter pole, angled to the seven path into the stretch run, rallied past the field to draw clear under good handling. SECRET RIDE had good speed to set a pressured pace, drew clear through the stretch but was run down late SHINE FOR STEVE tracked leaders to the stretch but weakened in the drive. CITY CODE chased leader to the stretch, made a bid to the eighth pole but was outfinished in the late going. SUNSHINE BOI well placed to the stretch with a mild gain in the drive. GROOVY ANNIE saved ground while evenly and lacked a late response when needed. ZEBULON ROAD failed to menace. MOROX never a menace. LEGIONARY was outrun.
