**Footnotes**

THE BIG BLOND stalked the pace racing near the inside to the stretch, angled out in upper stretch, rallied willingly through the final furlong and collared the pacesetter late to prevail. SMART PURSUIT dueled for the lead outside a rival early, went clear on the turn, widened in upper stretch, bore out through the lane and was caught late. MISS SHARES broke a step slow from the rail, rushed up inside rivals early, raced in midpack to the stretch and had a mild rally to gain third late. TAP KID chased the pace racing three wide to the stretch before weakening. NO ANCHOVIES raced between rivals in midpack on the turn but failed to produce a rally. EXCEPTIONAL WEAVE dueled inside of the runner up early, chased that one from the rail on the turn before tiring through the stretch. BRENDASWHINYBRAT raced four wide on the turn and was never a factor. VANDANIERE raced within striking range to the stretch before giving way. SLEW'S TREASURE showed little. WAR NOSE bore out on the turn and had her rider lose his inside iron and was never a factor. SWINGING JANIE GAL raced four wide while dropping back around the turn.
