MIZZTERBRIAN'SLUST was in a good stalking position while saving ground, got through along the rail and drew off, was under constant handling to the wire. RABIT HASH RIB was void of early speed, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. BLUE TIE AFFAIR dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, flattened out and ran evenly late. WILD BLING was unhurried early while six wide, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. FRANCIS MICHAEL dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. I'LL TAKE JACKS was in a good stalking position in mid pack, passed tiring rivals. CLASSIC RIDGE failed to menace. THREEQUARTER STAR flashed brief speed before stopping. LITTLE RISK showed good early speed while six wide, gave way and dropped back. ROWDY MARTY had brief foot, weakened.
