KIRGHIZ was unhurried early then continued to rally throughout from the rail, stayed on the rail into the far turn then took over command and drew off late in the stretch under a steady drive. SUDDENLY PERFECT was back early, while on the inside into the far turn then was up for place late while no match for the winner. ALLEY ANTHEM pressed the pace early then took over command, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late in the stretch drive. CAT ON set the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and gave way late in the stretch run. KINNAIRD angled into the five path in the far turn and improved position. DREWUP was fractious in the gate during the pre-start and moved up in the stretch. FARMINGTON was through after a half. SPORT SHOW had early speed then folded up. FASTEST CAT steadied into the first turn. FERBER eased late in the stretch and was vanned off.
