NATALMA'S LIGHT was unhurried early while saving ground, rallied on the far turn and got through, drew of in upper stretch and was under heavy pressure to hold the margin late. STRIKE N FLY was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. BUBBLEGUM BANDIT stalked the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. THIRTYFORSOUTHGATE was void of early speed, improved position but was no threat. LADY TOCCET was well placed while four wide, had no rally. SCOTTISH PRINCESS was in a good stalking position while saving ground, had no rally. ASIAN PROVERB was no factor. LIE N'GEORGE failed to menace. CLEARLY UNDISPUTED was no threat. ZIPPY CARLIE JOE was in a good stalking position, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. MOUNTAIN OF HONEY set the pace with good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
