NAPOLEON J was away quickly and set all of the pace while saving ground, drew clear on the turn, was fully extended to add to the margin late. C O RINGO was in a good stalking position in mid pack, improved position in the stretch but was no match for the winner. COMMUNAL was void of early speed while five wide, passed tiring rivals and was no threat. FAST PIKE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally, was vanned off after the race. MR ALL AMERICAN bobbled at the start and was rushed up, gave way and dropped back. OUTLAW ACADEMY was unhurried early while five wide, had no rally.
