WEEKEND WONDER was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. MAGICAL PARK dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. TENMOR was void of early speed, had a mild late rally while along the rail and was gaining but too late. CITIZEN JOHN prompted the pace early and then dueled for the lead, gave way and dropped back. VINQTIEME showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded. LIQUIDATION flashed brief speed before stopping. NATIVE YELL failed to menace.
