Footnotes

IMMORTAL WINK was unhurried early, rallied on the far turn and closed with a rush, drew off under heavy pressure. FINGER TAPPING was in a good stalking position with good early speed, rallied and pressed the pace, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. TICONDERO was well placed on the outside, rallied on the second turn, hung and faded. SWORD PLAY stalked the pace in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. ETHICS REFORM was no threat, was steadied at the quarter pole, had no rally. LEGIONARY was no factor, was steadied to avoid foe entering the stretch. UNCLE LES showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. QUEBEC CITY set the pace with good early speed, broke down and was vanned off.
