CASH OUT stalked and pressed the pace, rallied on the turn and into the stretch, drew clear late under constant urging. DANGEL dueled for the lead and set the pace, weakened in the stretch but was still second best. RED PEPPER MARTINI was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. MOONSHINE MAN was unhurried early, improved position but was no threat. KID CUGAT dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, gave way and dropped back. MCFRENCH was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally. BURLEY A was unhurried early, rallied on the turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. BAR TIME clipped heels early and was pinched back soon after the start, was no factor. ALLADINS CLOUD failed to menace. STORMY ATTITUDE showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. HOUSEBUILDER was no threat. LOUIE FLAMINGO flashed brief speed before stopping.
