HAPPY ENDINGS TOO settled well off the early pace, made a strong three wide middle move to challenge entering the final turn, dueled outside of the runner up around the bend, continued willingly through the drive and prevailed under aggressive handling. PATTI'S CLOWN dueled outside of IMAHONEYTOO for the first half mile and inside of the winner around the final turn, continued willingly to the wire and just missed while easily besting the rest. IMAHONEYTOO dueled along the rail, couldn't keep pace entering the second turn and tired. KHAKI LEE saved ground racing close up in midpack to the second turn, failed to produce a bid. LIMELIGHT DANCER showed little. GOTTHEMONEYHONEY chased the pacesetters for the first half mile before tiring badly. JODY JET was always outrun.
