CIANO NIGHTS dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, drew off in upper stretch, was all out to hold the margin late. FREEBEERTOMORROW stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch but found his best stride late and was gaining but too late. I SHALL RETURN dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. PRIME DIAMOND was in a good stalking position while five wide, ran evenly with no rally. SLIVER was taken up after the start, was never a factor. SOMETINSPECTACULAR was well placed while four wide, had no rally. BADCLOUDCOMING was no factor. AMERICAN MINER was no threat. CLEARLY CRYPTIC failed to menace. SILVER TALK RIB was steadied at the start and was no factor. SUNNY MARKET flashed brief speed before stopping. DARE HE GOES was no threat.
