DR. RYTHYM stalked the pace while saving ground, rallied on the turn and took command, drew off through the stretch under firm handling. CHIEF WATERBURY dueled for the lead and pressed the pace from between horses, could not go with the winner but was second best. ONE WAY OUT set the pace with good early speed, weakened in the stretch. QUICK TREND was void of early speed, improved position but was no threat. NAPOLEON J showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. SAY HEY CHARLIE was void of early speed, improved position but was no threat. TOP APPEAL was in a good stalking -position in mid pack, had no rally. COME ON GARCON failed to menace. UNWAVERING FLIGHT was no threat. DEVOTED FRIEND was no factor while eight wide and lost ground.
