DOUBLE MOCA sent hard from inside to set all the pace, stayed clear into the stretch as much the best. MAGNIFICENT MAX (GB) had an awkward start while far back, made a steady advance with a three wide run around the turn and rallied late for place. UNCLE LES never far back, floated very wide into the stretch with no late gain. SAINTHORATIO no speed to the final turn, made an inside run into the stretch and moved up in the drive. KARLENS stumbled at the start, raced well off rail into the stretch with no response when needed. FRANKIE'S FANTASY was never a factor. ELMER N MORT chased the winner for three quarters but faded from inside late. RED DIAMOND was through after a half. MY FRIEND BERNIE was never a threat.
