CHUCKS A DEVILGIRL bobbled at the start, stalked the pace in behind the dueling leaders, rallied into the stretch after being angled out, drew clear under firm handling. BLUE AS THE NILE was off slowly, duelled for the lead and set the pace, weakened and ran evenly late, was still second best. T. T.'S SURPRISE was well placed in mid pack, improved position but was no threat. CHELSEA'SMOUNTAIN set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. SECRET SONADOR was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. MAKE NICE was no factor. WHAT ABOUT MAEVE was no threat. KATIE EM lunged at the start and was then steadied, was no factor.
