Footnotes

SKY TAPS dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, drew off in upper stretch and was fully extended to the wire. STILL SMOLDERING was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. PHIL C was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. A FLEETING MEMORY showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. DEBS GONE WILD stalked the pace while four wide, faltered and faded. GIFTS FOR A KING was well placed in mid pack, had no rally. BOOGIEMANBALL was no threat. MILL POINT was six wide and had no rally. FAPPIE'S BOOKMORE set the pace and dueled while four wide, was used up and dropped back.
