AMAZIN broke alertly, raced just off the dueling leaders on the backstretch, advanced while three wide on the turn, took command and went clear approaching the stretch, widened through the drive under steady handling. FORTUNE LADY dueled for the lead outside rivals on the backstretch, was overtaken by the winner approaching the stretch but easily held second. RANAES PISTOL raced well back to the stretch before passing tired rivals. ASK LISA raced in midpack throughout and was never a factor. SOVEREIGN NATURE vied for the lead from between horses on the backstretch, remained a forward factor to the stretch before tiring. MANY BUCKS was outrun. CLARA B raced three wide on the turn and showed little. DEBT FREE raced four wide on the turn while being outrun. RED QUILLA COUNTRY dueled for the lead along the rail early, retreated quickly on the turn.
