Footnotes

DIXIE D' OR raced four wide on the first turn while in midpack, advanced quickly to reach contention entering the second turn, chased MIZ MARY SLEW around that bend, rallied outside rivals through the drive and prevailed under steady handling. MIZ MARY SLEW moved up outside of MIRACLE to take the lead on the first turn, drew clear on the backstretch, maintained a clear lead to midstretch, continued willingly and gamely saved the place. MARCY'S ANGEL raced three wide while between horses on the first turn, advanced along the rail on the second turn, angled out entering the stretch, loomed a threat from between horses leaving the furlong marker but hung late while failing to switch leads through the drive. CHANNEL VISION saved ground throughout and passed only tired rivals. WHERE'S MS. FENG was taken back early, moved up into midpack while racing four wide on the second turn but failed to sustain her run. PISTOLLA raced between horses in the two path around the first turn, was four wide on the second turn and showed little. NAVAJO BRIDE chased the pace to the second turn before tiring badly. MIRACLE raced close up along the rail early, was finished after the first half mile and distanced.
