PAY THE DEBT between horses early, stalked outside then alongside a rival on the turn, bid outside the pacesetter in the stretch, gained the lead under urging past the eighth pole and won clear. HARLINGTON'S ROSE sent inside early, saved ground stalking the pace, came out past midstretch and went around the pacesetter late for second. NINNAVEE had speed three deep then inched away leaving the backstretch, angled in and set the pace inside on the turn and into the stretch, fought back in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth and was overtaken for the place while saving third. YODELMESOMEMAGIC dropped back between horses then settled off the rail, went outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and was edged for the show. SILVER N SASSY stalked between horses then was shuffled back a bit into the turn, found the inside on the bend and weakened. GISELE AT FONZ'S a bit slow into stride then drifted out some early, stalked four wide then three deep, continued outside on the turn and into the stretch and also weakened. DEBT FREE ABBY between rivals early, chased a bit off the rail to the stretch and had little left for the drive.
