R S WATSON sent to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, responded when challenged into the stretch, inched away again while drifting out some from the whip in midstretch and held sway under urging. KING MAYA stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid outside the winner early on the backstretch then tracked again, bid again into the stretch then had that one slip away in midstretch and continued willingly but was outfinished. MAGNUM FORCE three deep into the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the second turn and bested the others. MILK MAN RAY had speed three wide then stalked outside a rival or off the rail to the stretch and weakened. CHICO SUERTE bobbled some at the start, pulled his way between horses to chase the pace, continued outside a rival on the backstretch and a bit off the fence on the second turn and also weakened. CAST A VISION three wide into the first turn, chased outside or alongside a rival, went three deep into the second turn, angled in outside a foe and had little left for the stretch. TUX saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn and weakened.
