AMERICAN ACT stalked outside then off the rail, bore out badly leaving the turn to come well wide into the stretch then rallied in the final furlong under urging to get up on the wire. SENOR RAIN pulled a bit and stalked inside, waited off heels leaving the turn, came out for room in midstretch, bid three deep to gain the lead a sixteenth out, inched away late and just failed to hold off the winner. CONSULADO chased off the rail then tugged his way between horses in a bit tight into the turn, stalked between foes, came out some in the stretch and edged a rival late for third. CHICKIE CHARMS dueled between horses then outside a rival on the turn, put a head in front on the bend, battled alongside a foe in the stretch and between horses again a sixteenth out and was edged late for the show. SIR ALLISON sent inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and weakened some late. DIAMOND OF BLUE prompted the pace three deep between horses, stalked three wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened.
