Footnotes

UTOPIAN stalked outside a rival or just off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the second turn and through the stretch, gained a slim advantage under urging nearing the wire and gamely prevailed. SMUG took the early lead and angled in, set the pace along the inside, fought back when challenged leaving the second turn and through a long drive and continued willingly to the wire. HOLLADAY ROAD broke a step slowly, stalked the pace alongside HAIMISH HY to the stretch, came out some in the drive and finished with interest but could not catch the top pair. HAIMISH HY saved ground in a good position tracking the pace to the stretch and weakened.
