(Winners are not eligible and will forfeit their nomination fee). All fees will be refunded to horses which fail to draw into this race. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

Footnotes

VALENTINE BOY stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, bid four wide past midstretch, gained the lead under urging in deep stretch and proved best. SIZZLIN' JOE sent between horses early then chased a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and just got the place. SIXTY STARS stalked off the rail then outside, came three wide into the stretch, bid three deep in midstretch, put a head in front past the eighth pole and held third. RAYA ROJA broke inward, settled wide then alongside a rival, came out in the stretch and improved position. ENDURING PROMISE wide early, dueled three deep, inched away and angled in on the turn, battled between horses in midstretch and weakened late. NIGHT WIND had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail, stalked on the turn, angled in and re-bid along the fence in the stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. FULL DANCER broke slowly, settled off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. JOLLY JOSEPH between foes early, chased outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. LOOK FOR ANSWERS settled a bit off the rail, split horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. BERTRANDO FALLS off a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside, steadied in tight midway on the turn and lacked a further response. JACO RED chased outside then three deep into and on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. SWIFT EAGLE settled outside a rival, split horses a half mile out and again on the turn, angled to the inside into the stretch and was not a threat. GOODBYE CHARLIE sent between horses to duel for the lead then stalked leaving the backstretch, dropped back between foes on the turn and gave way.
