Closed with 1. \$2,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,500 to start, with \$165,000 to the winner, \$57,000 to second, \$33,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth, \$9,000 to fifth and \$6,000 to sixth, seventh and eighth place finishers. Weight 124 lbs.

Footnotes

UNUSUAL HEATWAVE settled three deep then off the rail, continued outside on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up nearing the wire. STONEY FLEECE three deep on the first turn, chased outside, went up four wide leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and into the stretch, gained a short lead four across the track past midstretch and continued willingly but could not hold off the winner. DYLAN DONNELLY three deep into the first turn, stalked outside then alongside a rival, bid three wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch, gained the lead, battled between horses in midstretch and until deep stretch and bested the others. CORNER OFFICE saved ground chasing the pace, moved up along the rail leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, waited momentarily off heels early on that turn, came out for room into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. REAL CONUNDRUM angled in and stalked inside then was in a bit tight between foes into the second turn, bid between rivals leaving that turn and in the stretch and weakened late. D' OBSESSION pulled between horses then angled in and dueled inside, inched away briefly into the second turn, fought back along the rail leaving that turn and until past midstretch and weakened. TERAAD pulled his way along inside and was in a bit tight into the first turn, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, angled in again on the second turn and did not rally. BENCH LIGHT angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail, found the fence again on the second turn and could not offer the necessary response. SUANCES CANDY pulled his way along three deep then dueled outside a rival, dropped back between foes on the second turn and gave way. OH RIGHTY between foes early, stalked off the rail then between horses, dropped back into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
