TEASING BERNIE broke a bit slowly and was crowded, settled just off the rail, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and rallied under urging to be along in time. GOOD LITE stalked three deep then outside a rival, bid three wide into the stretch to gain the lead, battled alongside a foe and was caught late. NEW HIRE chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and went willingly between foes late. TRAWEEK settled between horses then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GRUMPY SMALL MOUTH between foes early, stalked outside then between horses leaving the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. RUN FOR MILES chased a bit off the rail then inside, waited momentarily then slipped through along the fence in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. J J'S JAGUAR sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out a bit into the stretch, dropped back between foes and weakened.
