RUNNING ISABELLA had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, drew off under left handed urging in the stretch and won clear. SECRET GENIUS chased outside then three deep on the turn, came out five wide into the stretch, drifted in and was second best. NIFTY DREAM settled between foes then a bit off the rail, angled to the inside into the stretch and picked up the show. KHERINGTON ANN unhurried off the rail then between foes a half mile out, continued outside a rival on the turn, came out in the stretch and improved position. RED INTRIGUE prompted the pace three deep then stalked outside a rival, continued three wide leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. PREDICTABLE chased a bit off the rail then inside on the backstretch and turn and did not rally. LILY'S TIZ forced the pace between foes then outside the winner, stalked on the turn, continued between rivals leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and wakened. DANCING JENNIFER moved up inside and saved ground stalking the pace, inched forward leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
