Footnotes

WARREN'S NICHOLAS angled in and chased outside a rival, split horses three deep into the second turn, came out five wide into the stretch, gained the lead five wide in midstretch and won clear under some urging. RED GLOBE broke slowly, settled inside then came out leaving the first turn, waited off heels three deep leaving the second turn, came out five wide into the stretch and gained the place. ACKMAN saved ground stalking the pace, came off the rail for room leaving the second turn but also waited off heels into the stretch, came out again in midstretch and just got the show. SOMETHINGS UNUSUAL angled in and chased inside, inched forward leaving the second turn, waited off heels into the stretch, steadied in tight again off heels in midstretch, split foes in deep stretch and just missed third between foes. GENTLEMEN PETE fanned four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep, bid four wide on the second turn and into the stretch, was between foes in the drive and was edged for a minor award. REAL HEAT stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid three deep between horses on the second turn and into the stretch, battled between foes in midstretch and weakened late. BUDDING AFFAIR had speed

between foes then angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and to midstretch, then weakened. UNUSUAL LOVER angled in and dueled outside a rival then between horses on the second turn, also fought back to midstretch and weakened. CITY STATE fanned five wide into the first turn, chased outside a rival then outside foes leaving the backstretch, came five wide into the stretch, drifted in and did not rally. PUERTO WILLIAMS pulled his way between horses then drifted out into the first turn, chased three deep, dropped back between horses on the second turn, angled in some and gave way. GELATO D'ORO broke in and steadied, trailed just off the rail, came out some in the stretch and was outrun.
