KATY'S KITTY was in a good position stalking the pace three deep to the stretch, bid three wide, gained the lead past the eighth pole and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. LIKA pulled a bit and stalked three deep then outside a rival, continued off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving that turn, put a head in front between foes nearing midstretch, fought back inside the winner in deep stretch and just held second. R VICARIOUS GIRL a bit slow to begin, angled in and settled outside a rival, came out in the stretch and just missed the place. SAINT CINDY chased between horses or a bit off the rail, continued between foes on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. BURLEYS LEAP had good early speed outside a rival, inched away and angled in leaving the first turn, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, fought back to deep stretch and weakened some late. POWERS LILSIS had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and also weakened some late. NEGRA TOMASA a bit slow into stride, pulled her way along to chase the pace inside to the stretch, came off the fence in midstretch and did not rally.
