Footnotes

POTESTA had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, kicked clear on the second turn and drew off through the stretch under a long hold. KE KUKUI prompted the pace three deep then stalked outside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch, drifted in through the drive and was clearly second best. ROXANNE O broke slowly to be away behind the field, settled inside then a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. ANTRIM'S LEGEND three deep into the first turn, angled in on that bend and saved ground off the pace, came out some leaving the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. DUBAI CYCLONE prompted the pace between horses, angled in and stalked on the second turn and weakened. PERPETUA broke slowly, pulled her way along off the rail and steadied into the first turn and again leaving that turn, chased outside a rival then inside on the second turn and also weakened. HOLLYWOOD CHIC saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
