BOAT TRIP chased outside a rival, moved up three deep leaving the backstretch and four wide into the stretch, bid three wide in midstretch, gained the lead approaching the sixteenth marker under left handed urging and gamely prevailed. GNARLY DUDE squeezed in a bit tight early, angled in and saved ground, moved up inside into the stretch, bid along the rail to put a head in front as the rider lost the whip past the eighth pole and continued gamely to the end. SABOR AMARGO (CHI) stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch, was in tight off heels in midstretch, came out some and bested the others. ALIZA'S DREAM chased off the rail, steadied in a bit tight between horses into the turn, continued off the inside leaving the turn and lacked the needed rally. CAUGHT A FLYER sped to the early lead, set the pace along the rail on a clear advantage, came off the fence in the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and weakened. SPRINGFIELD ALLEY settled outside then dropped back and angled in a bit off the rail to the stretch and was not a threat. SAMMY'S A RUNNIN' dropped back and settled off the rail to the stretch and did not rally. SOLAR ROCKET pulled between horses then stalked off the rail, continued outside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened.
