COMMA TO THE TOP had speed between horses then angled in, dueled inside, inched away on the turn, kicked clear under urging and was under a long hold late while drifting out a bit in the lane. ITALIAN RULES chased outside then three deep, continued outside on the turn and three wide into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. AIN'T NO OTHER saved ground stalking the pace, cut the corner into the stretch, continued inside and was edged late for second. CENTRALINTELIGENCE settled a bit off the rail then inside on the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. MAUI MARK also settled off the pace inside then a bit off the fence, went outside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. L. A. WEEKEND angled in and dueled outside the winner, stalked just off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. COURTSIDE chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn and also weakened. MARK'S CAT stalked three deep then outside a rival early on the turn, dropped back between foes leaving the turn and gave way.
