UNUSUAL WAY duelled inside, inched away leaving the turn, drew clear late while drifting out under steady handling. AWESOME ANNIE four wide early, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch, drifted in late and was second best. SHRINKING VIOLET prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked leaving the turn and into the stretch, also drifted in late and just held third. MISS EMPIRE tossed her head some in a slow start, chased outside a rival, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and just missed the show. KIPTIDDY DO angled in early and saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside in the stretch and lacked a response in the drive. CHAIN OF GOODS a step slow into stride, raced a bit greenly behind horses into the turn, split horses leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response. PANFILA broke out and bobbed in a slow start, trailed off the rail, angled in some for the turn, came out in the stretch and failed to menace.
