Footnotes

PRIVATE BOUNTY stalked four wide then outside foes leaving the backstretch, bid three deep on the turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away and won clear under a moderate hand ride and a long hold late. WHAT A RUSH chased off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and picked up the place. KUMITE broke a bit slowly and was squeezed, settled just off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch, split rivals in late stretch and gained the show. MOONLIGHT BEACH sent between horses to chase the pace, came out three deep into the stretch and was edged for third. WILD GRAY saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked the needed rally but was outfinished for a minor award. LINCECUM stalked outside a

rival, bid between horses on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CRAGMONT chased between horses on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn and did not rally. MERLIN Z had good early speed off the rail, dueled between horses on the backstretch, inched away briefly and angled in on the turn, battled inside leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened. WARREN'S PATRON broke a bit slowly, settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. BREAKMARK broke a bit slowly, settled toward the inside then came out leaving the backstretch, went four wide on the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. CONGRATS SKI was sent between horses then pressed the pace inside, stalked on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened.
