BI FLASH sent inside to the early lead, inched away and set the pace along the rail, opened up under left handed urging in the stretch and won clear. AMERICAN TANKER settled along the inside, split horses into the second turn, came out leaving that turn and four wide into the stretch and just got the place. YOU KNOW I KNOW chased between horses then a bit off the rail, moved up inside then steadied in tight off heels midway on the backstretch, was shuffled back into the second turn, came out then angled back in leaving that turn, came out again in midstretch, split horses in deep stretch and on the wire and just missed second. NOBLE KENT pulled his way along to stalk the pace a bit off the rail then inside to the stretch, continued along the rail in the drive and weakened late. SOI PHET four wide into the first turn, chased outside then alongside a rival, continued off the rail on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BIG MAN IN BLACK chased outside, moved up three deep on the second turn, angled in outside a rival into the stretch and weakened. R U EXPERIENCED broke a bit slowly, settled inside, came off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep into the second turn and did not rally. EL BRONCO pulled his way between horses, stalked outside a rival or off the rail, dropped back between foes leaving the second turn and gave way.
