Footnotes

CANULETMEDOWNEASY stalked the pace off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter in upper stretch, took a short lead three deep in midstretch and held on gamely under urging. NO SILENT wide early, chased outside then alongside a rival, split horses approaching the turn, found the rail on the bend, bid inside in the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. SOUTHERN SUNRISE sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, came out some into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and held third. FABLE HAVEN chased between horses or outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, split horses past midstretch and was edged for the show. MY BEST BROTHER stalked outside, bid three deep into the turn, tracked off the rail on the bend and three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ET TU WALKER broke slowly, settled outside then three deep leaving the backstretch, angled in on the turn, found the rail into the stretch and could not offer the necessary rally. MEL'S GAME broke slowly, drifted out and steadied leaving the chute, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and improved position. ERIC THE RAM chased between horses then three deep into and on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. ENGLISH PREP saved ground chasing the pace throughout and did not rally. WAR FACE broke slowly, pulled his way along inside, steadied in tight into the turn, came out off heels midway on the bend and into the stretch and did not rally. ATTICLUDE chased a bit off the rail then between horses approaching the turn, continued just off the inside on the turn and was not a threat. WHITE STAR LINE bobbled at the start,

was forced wide leaving the chute, trailed off the rail, angled in some for the turn and failed to menace.
