Footnotes

HUNCH pulled his way along to stalk between horses then outside a rival on the turn and into the stretch, lacked room off heels in midstretch, came out and rallied under urging to get up three wide on the wire. POSITION A saved ground stalking the pace, bid along the rail in the stretch, gained the lead past midstretch and continued willingly but was edged late. MASTER CHEF had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, battled three wide in midstretch and fought back willingly between foes late. DRIFT KING reluctant to load, had speed between rivals then dueled inside, put a head in front on the turn, fought back between horses in midstretch and weakened in the late stages. BERTRAN HILL pulled his way up to stalk three wide then off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
