ROSSI RESERVE pulled her way to the early lead and set the pace off the inside, dueled three deep on the backstretch and turn, gained the advantage again into the stretch, inched away under urging and held. PLAZARITA angled in and stalked inside, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some and finished willingly but could not catch the winner. NEGRA TOMASA chased four wide then three deep, continued off the rail into the turn, angled to the inside on the bend, then went around a rival late for the show. WARRENS CHINA DOLL pulled early and stalked inside, bid along the rail to put a head in front on the backstretch, dueled inside on the turn and into the stretch and weakened but lost third late. RACY ROSA a bit slow into stride, stalked just off the rail then bid between horses to duel for the lead on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. GLORIFIED (GB) broke a bit slowly, went up between rivals to chase the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch, gave way and was eased through the drive.
