FOLLINI had speed between foes then dueled inside, lugged in a bit nearing midstretch, inched away in deep stretch and held gamely under left handed urging. LUCKY COTTON hopped slightly in a bit of a slow start, settled just off the rail, went around a rival on the turn, angled to the inside into the stretch, came out in the drive and closed willingly to get up for second four wide on the line. TRIBAL DUDE had good early speed and dueled between horses then outside the winner on the turn, battled between foes again in the stretch and continued willingly to hold third. DREAMNOFATTICUS chased outside then alongside a rival, continued just off the rail on the turn, found the inside in the stretch and finished with interest. ART OFFICIAL angled in and stalked outside a rival or a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, bid three wide in midstretch, was between foes late and was outfinished. WARREN'S T. BAZE a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, split horses into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WHICH WAY HANK broke a bit slowly and was squeezed, settled outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SAINT LEO pulled his way along four wide then pressed the pace three deep, fell back outside on the turn and weakened. HANDSOME SAM broke inward, had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the turn and into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
