Footnotes

BOREALIS WAY chased between horses then off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and rallied under left handed urging to wear down the runner-up late. ENDURING PROMISE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn and held on well a bit off the rail but was caught late. D J DAVE stalked inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and went willingly to the wire. BRINGON THE WAIN broke in, dueled outside the runner-up, fought back in the stretch, was in a bit tight between foes a sixteenth out and was outfinished. JACO RED stalked three deep then outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and also was outfinished late. PRIDDIS WILDCAT chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. A B C CITY broke a bit slowly then bobbed on the second step to drop back, settled off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. HUNTSVILLE a bit slow into stride, angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued inside in the stretch and lacked the needed response. WARREN'S DR. BOO broke slowly and was green inside runners in the chute, saved ground off the pace, went around a rival in deep stretch and was not a threat. QUICK SAVE angled in and chased off the rail then a bit off the fence into and on the turn, gave way in the stretch.
