PIRATE'S PLEASURE had good early speed inside and set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged leaving the turn and into the stretch, inched away again in midstretch, drifted out a bit then in from the whip in deep stretch but held gamely. BROTHER PETE wide in the chute, settled outside a rival then found the rail on the backstretch, came out leaving the turn, angled to the inside and waited briefly in midstretch, got through along the fence in deep stretch, came out some nearing the wire and went on willingly. INCLINE VILLAGE was a bit slow to begin and in tight just after the start, chased outside a rival or just off the rail, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and finished with interest. BROKER BRETT between foes early, angled in and chased inside, came off the rail quarter mile out, angled out into the stretch and was outfinished. CONCORDE WEST had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, bid alongside the winner leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. DEWRAG hesitated then broke inward onto the winner and behind the field, saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. SILECTICO had speed three deep then stalked off the rail or outside a rival, angled in some and dropped back on the turn, found the rail in upper stretch and gave way.
