JOVITA'S TUFFY stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, came out three wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up nearing the wire. STORMIN LUTE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away in the stretch and held on well but was caught late. A RED TIE DAY chased outside a rival on the backstretch and again on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. MAJOR AFFAIR broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then angled in some off the inside approaching the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SPECTRUS dueled three deep on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the final furlong. SPIRITED TOUCH went up between horses to press the pace, battled between foes on the turn and weakened in the stretch. SIMON SAYS GO hesitated to be away behind the field, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out some in the stretch and was not a factor.
