Footnotes

PLAZARITA pulled early, chased off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, gained the lead under urging a sixteenth out and held gamely between foes late. DERBY MEMO chased inside then tugged her way between foes on the backstretch, angled in approaching the second turn, came out in the stretch and finished with interest three deep on the line. DUSTIN'S MAGIC stalked outside a rival or off the rail, moved up three deep into the second turn, bid alongside a foe, gained the advantage a quarter mile out, inched away in the stretch, fought back in the final sixteenth and continued willingly to the end. RAGGIN WOOD sent to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. FOOTNOTEDISCLOSURE also sent between horses, stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival, was between foes into the second turn, fell back and weakened. SAND BRIDLED chased three deep, dropped back into and on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch. BENCH BEAUTY between horses early, drifted out while being pulled up on the first turn and was vanned off.
