Footnotes

AWE' SOME KITTEN sent inside, dueled along the rail, inched away in the stretch and won clear under a tap of the whip and a strong hand ride. LUCKY STUDENT also was sent along to press the pace outside the winner, could not match that one in the final furlong but was clearly second best. ELLA BEA AWESOME chased three deep then outside on the turn, angled in alongside a rival into the stretch and split horses late for the show. GAMBLER'S BEAUTY sent along outside then chased off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and just missed third four wide on the line. IT'S AINE three deep early, split horses leaving the backstretch, stalked outside a rival on the turn, came out some into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award between foes on the wire. JILLY BAYLEE angled in and stalked inside, came out slightly into the stretch and could not offer the needed late response toward the rail. ANGEL BE QUICK broke in a bit, chased just off the rail then inside on the turn and in the stretch and weakened. SPRING SARAH hesitated to be away behind the field, angled in and saved ground, continued inside on the turn and was not a threat. MISS DENNY broke slowly, settled off the rail, lugged out some on the turn and was outrun.
