SIZZLING GOLD prompted the pace three deep then outside the runner-up leaving the turn, took the advantage in upper stretch, inched away in deep stretch and proved best under urging. TASTY TREAT had good early speed and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but held second. DARLING DODIE chased outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came out some in the stretch and bested the others. GOLDENTOUCH OF GIN a bit slow to begin, settled inside, split horses past midstretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. KISS MY SWISS saved ground stalking the pace, went around a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MARY CONTRARY forced the pace between horses then angled in and stalked leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. ABELLA hopped slightly in a bit of a slow start, chased inside then just off the rail, was between foes into the turn, angled to the inside again and did not rally. DISTANT GLOW also a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival then three deep into the turn, angled in some on the bend and was not a threat.
