DANDEREK (GB) sped to the early lead, angled to the inside in the chute, set all the pace along the rail, opened up again under left handed urging in the stretch and held. RENEGADE STORM settled off the pace inside, came out in the stretch and edged a rival late for the place. ANTIDOTE close up stalking the winner a bit off the rail to the stretch, could not catch that one and was edged late for second. FALCON ROCK (IRE) chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out slightly in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. JAIRZIHNO (GB) saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and lacked a further response. ERBEIA four wide in the chute, chased three deep then outside a rival to the stretch and weakened. AIN saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail into the second turn, continued alongside a rival on that turn, dropped back, was eased up in the final furlong, unsaddled a pole from the wire and vanned off.
