Footnotes

MASTER RUDY bobbed slightly at the start, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch, split horses to gain the lead in midstretch and drew clear under urging. ON HOLY GROUND between rivals early, chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out three wide into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and again late for the place. FIRST BLUE ANGEL settled outside, split horses leaving the backstretch, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and gained the show late. MR. NEWTON saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch, bid along the rail in midstretch, was no match for the winner in the final furlong and was outfinished late for a minor award. SWEET ELATION broke slowly, went up between horses then dueled inside,

drifted off the rail into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. DR. EVIL broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, moved up some in the drive and improved position. DENNY THE GREAT stalked outside then off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. BIKE PATH had speed off the rail then dueled outside a rival, was floated out some into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CHAPITO wide early, chased outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. FERVEO chased between horses on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. OAK TREE DRIVE wide early, dropped back outside, angled to the inside on the turn and did not rally. SOCKS DON'T MATCH stalked between horses then off the rail, continued outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
